QUESTION: WHAT ABOUT DINOSAURS? WERE THEY ON THE ARK?

- **Two Views:**

1. _____: **Dinosaurs first evolved (or were created) approximately 235 Million years ago. However, approximately 65 Million years ago, they became extinct due to some cataclysmic event, such as the earth being struck by an asteroid. This all happened long before human beings evolved (or were created).**

2. _____: **Dinosaurs were created on the Sixth Day of Creation as were other land animals and man. Thus, dinosaurs and man lived contemporaneously.**
