**RADICAL**

**Beliefs or actions that are \_\_\_\_\_ of belief or behavior and are viewed as extreme, excessive or fanatical by the majority.**

**RADICAL GRACE REQUIRES ME TO ...**

He will put the sheep on His right and the goats on His left.”

**1. RECOGNIZE REALITY ABOUT THE \_\_\_\_\_.**

“Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent Him. “Very truly I tell you, whoever hears My word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.”

You a stranger and invite You in, or needing clothes and clothe You? When did we see You sick or in prison and go to visit You? “The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of Mine, you did for Me.’” Matthew 25:34-40 (NIV)

“Then He will say to those on His left, ‘Depart from Me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave Me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not invite Me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe Me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after Me.’” “They also will answer, ‘Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help You?’” “He will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for Me.’” “Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.” Matthew 25:41-46 (NIV)
